**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Anaheim Transportation Network (ATN) Board of Directors will hold a public hearing at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 25, 2012, at the Anaheim Convention Center Mezzanine Conference Room located at 800 West Katella Avenue, Anaheim, California. The public hearing shall be for the purpose of considering service expansion for the Anaheim Resort Transit system. No changes in the regular fare structure are proposed.

### **NEW PROPOSED ART ROUTE 18 -- SERVICE BETWEEN THE ANAHEIM RESORT DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF BUENA PARK**

The proposed new service is being considered to improve travel options and connectivity between major Orange County destinations and service for the employees of the Anaheim Resort and Buena Park business establishments. Information regarding the specific bus route alignments, proposed bus stop locations and new fare media for an all-day inclusive 1-day pass, weekly pass and monthly pass will be presented at the Public Hearing.

### **NEW PROPOSED ART ROUTE 19-- SERVICE BETWEEN THE ANAHEIM RESORT DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF SANTA ANA**

The proposed new service is being considered to improve travel options and connectivity between major Orange County destinations and service for the employees of the Anaheim Resort and Santa Ana business establishments. Information regarding the specific bus route alignments, proposed bus stop locations and new fare media for an all-day inclusive 1-day pass, weekly pass and monthly pass will be presented at the Public Hearing.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:** Interested persons may submit, orally or in writing, recommendations and evidence with respect to the proposed service expansion (ART Routes 18 and 19), as well as introduction of the new fare media by January 12, 2012.
